TO THE PEOPLE OF KANSAS, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Amateur Radio Operators are celebrating over a century of broadcast over the airwaves; and

WHEREAS, Amateur Radio has continued to provide a bridge of worldwide communication between peoples, societies, and countries by creating friendships and the sharing of ideas through broadcast; and
